Tips for the Day of One World Many Stories Magic Program

1. Steven will need a power outlet or power cord available near the performance area.
2. Please make sure there is plenty of room for the kids to sit comfortably. If they are too close to the performance area they will get cricks in the neck. Especially if they are sitting on the floor.
3. If the performance is outside please have an area ready indoors in case of rain.
4. I recommend encouraging parents to stay and watch the program with their children.
5. You may want to have books ready for the kids to check out after the program. Here is a list that goes along with reading topics I will bring up during the show:
 1. Magic Tricks
 2. Books that are magical. Example: Harry Potter, Chronicles of Narnia, etc
 3. China
 4. Harry Houdini
 5. Scotland Yards
 6. Egypt

7. Pyramids
